The World Affairs Council of Eastern NC (WAC-ENC) through a grant from the Turkish Cultural Foundation can make it happen.


The Turkish Cultural Foundation is sponsoring a 10-day study tour of Turkey in summer 2010 for middle and high school humanities teachers or administrators in Eastern North Carolina. WAC-ENC can nominate up to four participants.

Tentative dates are:

June 28-July 9; July 12-23; or July 26-Aug 6

- The cost is \$600 registration fee (toward the cost of the trip) and travel to New York or Chicago (the Turkish Airlines departure cities). In addition to these expenses, teachers are advised by the Turkish Cultural Foundation to budget approximately \$100 for tips to guides and drivers and approximately \$25 for visa fees.
- International airfare, lodging, food, tours, and in-country travel costs will be paid by the TCF. The TCF will organize the tours and all in-country logistics.
- Participants must attend Spotlight on Turkey Teacher Workshop on March 27 on the East Carolina University campus as well as several activities in fall 2010.
